

## SKATE PARK RULES Hours of Operation: Dawn-Dark

- •This skatepark is unsupervised. The City of Greenbrier will not be held responsible for accidents. Know your ability and skate at your own risk.
- •Helmets are required for ALL participants. Elbow pads, knee pads, wrist guards and other protective equipment are strongly recommended.
- •Skate park is for skateboards, inline skates and roller skates only. BMX bikes, bicycles, scooters, cycles of any kind or other devices are prohibited.
- •Drugs, alcohol, ALL tobacco products, vaping devices, abusive/foul language, fighting, horseplay, vandalism, glass containers, litter, pets, food and beverages are strictly prohibited in the skating area.
- •No activity is permitted when surface is wet, icy, or otherwise unsafe due to debris.
- •No radios or music may be played without the use of headphones.
- •No spectators are allowed in the skating area unless supervising a participant.
- •Participants under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult. Children under the age of 5 are not allowed to skate.
- •This skatepark has been designed for all skill levels. Be courteous to others using the facility.
- •Skating against traffic flow is dangerous and can cause serious injury. Do not proceed down a ramp until clear of other users.
- •No other items such as benches, tables, homemade ramps, or other objects may be used as ramps in this facility.
- •Skating in areas outside of the designated skate park is prohibited.
- •Failure to follow these rules may result in ejection from the facility, suspension from all City of Greenbrier recreation facilities and possible punishment to the full extent of the law. All rules and regulations cited in City of Greenbrier ordinances will apply.
