## **OLD BUSINESS**

1) Snowden Circle Rezone R-1 to R-2 (Public Hearing)

Tim Tyler spoke as representative for the property owner Tony Thompson. After consideration, the owner has decided to build 2 duplexes, 2,000 sq. ft. in size for each duplex with one building per lot.

Trish Nelson -28 Snowden Circle spoke against the rezone, stating she was good with the R-1 zone, she would like to keep it that way, no need for apartments in the area.

Fred Gates -- 23 Snowden Circle spoke against the rezone, stating he does not think duplexes will be good, houses would be fine. He would like to keep it zoned R-1, the subdivision is quiet, has narrow streets, he would like it to stay as is unless the city wants to build a new street with curb/gutter.

Tony Thompson---owner of the property spoke stating the original plan was to build 2 duplexes on the 6-acre tract to help supplement his income.

After reviewing, Hunter Thrasher made a motion to deny the rezone request from R-1 to R-2. Tim Carter seconded, all voted in favor.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

1) Lot Split Broadview Acres –Derek Walter

Mr. Walter was seeking approval for a lot split. The original lot split was never filled with the county. After discussion, Hunter Thrasher made a motion to approve the lot split at Broadview Acres. Johnny Cardin seconded, all voted in favor.
